SECTION VII. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

Marking/Labeling Requirement
Page No. 72 (attached Technical Specifications)

- Shall conform with the Consumer Act of the Philippines (RA 7394)

Article 77. Minimum Labeling requirements for consumer products, states that;

"All consumer products domestically sold whether manufactured locally or imported shall indicate the following in their respective labels of packaging:

- a) Its correct and registered trade name or brand name;*
- b) Its duly registered trademark;*
- c) Its duly registered business name;*
- d) The address of the manufacturer, importer, repacker of the consumer product in the Philippines;*
- e) Its general make or active ingredients (if applicable);*
- f) The net quality of contents, in terms of weight, measure or numerical count rounded or to at least the nearest tenths in the metric system (if applicable);*
- g) Country of manufacture, if imported; and*
- h) If a consumer product is manufactured, refilled or repacked under license from a principal, the label shall so state the fact."*

To specify the minimum Marking/Labeling requirements for consumer products.

All other portions of the Bidding Documents affected by these amendments shall be made to conform to the same.

Amendments/inclusions/clarifications made herein shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents.

The changes made in the Philippine Bidding Documents (5th Edition, August 2016) are deemed integrated in the terms and conditions for this project.
