Spare parts (page 65) ➤ no need for spare parts since units will be immediately replaced one found defective 	The requirements state that the winning bidder should have its spare parts available so that it could support its commitment of immediate replacement for items found defective.

To emphasize that radio communication will be within the engagement area only. However, there should be no failure of communication within the said area.

7.	Section VII: Technical Specifications. ➤ Request to amend the MIL Standard requirement to IP57 from IP67	Original requirement is retained.
8.	Section VII: Technical Specifications. ➤ Request that the Text Messaging Feature be optional.	Original requirement is retained.
9.	Section VII: Technical Specifications ➤ Request that the LCD Display feature be optional.	Original requirement is retained.

10.	Section VII: Technical Specifications > Request to amend the Battery capacity to 1500mAH from 1800mAh.	Original requirement is retained.
