Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 to clarify and/or amend¹ certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for this project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the **Pre-Bid Conference** held on **25 June 2019**, likewise, respond to bidders' written queries received within the prescriptive period for filing.

2.	JAC Motors also clarifies if the number of years for the brand of the vehicle be reduced to 10 years continuously in the market.	End user retains the 15 years continuous availability in the market.
3.	JAC Motors requested a 90CDs delivery period for the actual units.	End user retains the 60 CDs delivery period of the Actual units.
4.	JAC Motor again requested for the replacement of DOHC to SOHC requirement of the vehicle.	End user decided to eliminate or not to include the DOHC
5.	Nissan Commonwealth requested for the transmission be changed to Manual, likewise Toyota Quezon Ave. also suggest for the Manual in compliance with ABC.	End user retains the Automatic Transmission
