CONSTRUCTION OF ASCOM FACILITIES AT CAMP AQUINO, TARLAC FOR THE BASES CONVERSION AND DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY

Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 to clarify and/or amend¹ certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for this project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the **Pre-Bid Conference** held on **14 August 2020**, likewise, respond to bidders' written queries received within the prescriptive period for filing.

 Prospective Bidder must have at least a license category "AAA" and a license classification "Large B" from the Philippine Contractor Accreditation Board (PCAB) for General Engineering Building. The PCAB license must be valid and effective at the time of submission of the bid. Clarification if the SBAC could provide the exact PCAB License Classification for the "General Engineering" works which is composed of 5 classification, being a requirement of the PCAB for the JV's application for special contractor's license. As advised by the PCAB, the "General Engineering" classification is too broad and thus required us to submit the specific classification for the said general engineering works. 	The exact required PCAB License Classification is "General Building" specifically GB-1 (Building or Industrial Plant).

And any cost attendant thereto shall be chargeable to the contractor.
Is there any tapping point for water and power supply in the existing camping nearby the site? And what is the distance.	For further clarification after the site visit and shall be answered on the next bid bulletin.
Considering the proposed project is upgrading work of existing military camping, is there any mandatory rules and regulations within the site?	This is not an upgrading work of existing military camping but this is a new construction of ASCOM Facilities. The rules and regulations will be answered in the next bid bulletin.

4	A prospective Bidder inquired on who will shoulder the cost for acquiring permits and licenses for the procurement project.	Kindly refer to SCC Clause 1.31.
