2	Bill of Quantities		For the Preliminary Conceptual Design Plans for Utility Relocation. Because of the unavailability of the As- built drawings indicating the existing lay-out and details of the existing utilities, we find it so hard to prepare the relocation preliminary conceptual design. Further to our request to provide the Provisional Amount for this pay item, it follows that the said Conceptual Design may not be needed for these bidding stages only. This must be provided by the winning contractor during the Implementation Period as basis for the	Existing Utility Plan and Preliminary Conceptual Drawing were provided and included in the Bid Documents. For the coordination with the concerned Utility Agency, DOTr may assist upon award of contract.

We are still doing further verification and due-diligence works. b. Preparation of the required Detailed Unit Price Analysis which we need more time to review to established a more competitive and complying bid. c. Lastly, we have to make sure of the Completeness of our Bid based on the Bid Submittals required under this Bidding. 5		May we ask pomaam, after cutting or dismantle of trees , what we will do to that po?	Cut trunks/logs located in public property (such as center islands, sidewalks, etc.) and in areas under projects of National Greening Program (NGP) sites shall be disposed to the National Ecology Center (NEC) at DENR Office under jurisdiction of DENR-NCR-Enforcement Division. Ideal/ Allowable measurements of trunks/ logs disposed at NEC shall be at least 20cm by 2m length – based on DENR standard under FMB Technical Bulletin. Other trunks, branches, twigs and leaves shall be disposed by the tree cutting and earthballing Contractor/Subcontractor/s. For cut trunks/logs from the lots acquired by DOTr within private properties will be disposed at DOTr's temporary laydown area for documentation which will be transferred through Deed of Transfer to receiving LGUs for furniture making, charcoal making or for whatever purpose. Other trunks, branches, twigs and leaves shall also be disposed by the tree cutting and earthballing Contractor/Subcontractor/s. Temporary laydown area will be advised by DOTr upon award.
6	APB Construction	May we ask about the Conceptual Design format such as Title Block and who are the signatories needed?	There is no specific format for the Conceptual Design. Bidders could use their own title block for the submission.
