PUBLIC BIDDING NO. 23-035-2

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF MARKER, FLUORESCENT
FOR THE PROCUREMENT SERVICE (PS)

Issued pursuant to Sec. 22.5 of the IRR of R.A. 9184 to clarify and/or amend certain provisions in the Bidding Documents issued for this project, considering the issues raised and clarifications made by prospective bidders during the **Pre-Bid Conference** held on **27 June 2023**.

A. AMENDMENTS

If the test result shows compliance within the first 100 meters, it shall be accepted.

By Rules, all other related provisions in the Bidding Documents correspondingly affected by these amendments are likewise deemed amended to conform to this Bid Bulletin.

Amendments/inclusions/clarifications made herein shall be considered an integral part of the Bidding Documents.
