1	General Bid Bulletin No. 6, Annex "A", item 3	<p><u>Clarification Request:</u> Bidder would like to know if the Contractor will still be required by the Employer to acquire a Special Contractor's license under PCAB to start his work? Or the Business license and SEC Certificate of registration are already enough to start his operation instead?</p> <p><u>Response in GBB No. 6, item 3 of Annex "A":</u> The Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) requirement is currently under review and this item may be discussed with the lowest evaluated substantially responsive Bidder during contract negotiations to resolve any outstanding issues.</p>	<p>Further to the previous referenced response in General Bid Bulletin (GBB) No. 6, the winning Bidder, as the Contractor, shall be in possession of or shall have obtained, a PCAB Special License (foreign Contractor for a single project) before the Contractor shall commence the execution of the Works.</p> <p>For the Bidder's convenience, requirements for obtaining a PCAB Special License are enclosed as Annexes "B" and "C" of this GBB. However, it shall be the responsibility of the Bidder to liaise directly with the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB), and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) of the Republic of the Philippines, to confirm the requirements.</p>
