As shown on the above drawing, temporay PNR alignment locate very close to the at grade structure of SCRP, even drainage structure is underneath temporay PNR, so there is no space for construction work (ex. structural excavation, equipment & labor access, temporay retaining facilities, safety fecne / hoarding, etc.), while right side of ROW has enough space. Please provide detailed information on overall Temporary PNR operating plan and work sequence for the twice relocation of temporary PNR during the construction period in CP S-03a with consideration of above drawing of typical Sections. | The relocation works by PNR will relocate the current double track to a single track. Any relocation by PNR during the construction period of CP S-03a will be coordinated in accordance with Contractor's Programme. The Bidder shall comply with requirements as stated in GS 131 for the railway safety zone and any works to be carried out within the PNR railway and safety zone including but not limited to any works to be carried out outside railway operational hours.
