He stated that contractors should do their own approach to established contact with other interested contractors.
		Undersecretary Batan of DOTr also commented that business development strategy of the contractor is up to them. USec. Batan further explained that they are prohibited from facilitating any linkages between contractors, the

		contracts that they are procuring, and the subcontracts that they will get. It is entirely up to the contractors.
