back to Sniper Rifle instead of Rifle. He explained that during the first bidding they were not able to participate because they cannot comply with the requirement. They were forced to find a manufacturer who can comply with the similar contract. Atty. Recto stated that the requirement for the similar contract will remain to be Rifle. She explained that the requirement was relaxed based on the ground that the requirement for similar contract should only be similar and should not necessarily be the identical. Rifle as similar contract is broader in scope but is analogous to the item required. On the matter raised by Mr. Tejero that they were not able to participate on the first bidding because of the requirement of similar contract. Stating further that they would not have entered into a JV, if the SLCC was relaxed from the very beginning. Dir Fajardo explained that the project requires that the bidders must be a manufacturer themselves of the item being procured as required in the AFP Modernization Act. Atty. Recto seconded the explanation offered by Dir Fajardo, that the requirement is consistent from the beginning that the bidders for the project must be a supplier who are manufacturers themselves or who at least has partner that is a manufacturer. SECTION VI SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS No highlights. SECTION VII The following were raised and clarified: The three (3) samples to be used during the post qualification are not included in the 60 units to be delivered. During the Pre-Delivery Inspection team will be composed not more than five (5) members of the inspecting party. Cold Forged Barrel is acceptable as finish for the barrel. **TECHNICAL** SPECIFICATIONS Either Semi-Automatic or Bolt Action is acceptable for the Operating System. The Upper Receiver has no specific number of railing system but must have a railing system. The Long Range/Tactical Optics of the Rifle Scope must have an illum. The Rifle Scope must range must be at least 3-18mm x 44mm. The sight must have a back up iron sight (BUIS). The requirement for being
