	> Engr. Navarrete clarified that each bidder is required to submit one (1) original and (2) copies of first and second components of bids.

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7. Additionally, the Supplier shall furnish the PS-Technical Working Group with the following documents as proof of the existence of the Authorized Service Centers, to wit:

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- a. Business or Mayor's Permit of the authorized company's (manufacturer) service centers; xxx"
- Ms. Undon raised a concern regarding the required Mayor's Permit of the Service Centers. She said that most of the Service Centers are franchise dealers, who belongs to another company, and that they may not be allowed to secure copy of the Mayor's Permit.
- Mr. Sanchez raised the same concern with Ms. Undon. He said that for
 those who belong to small dealership like them, they can probably provide
 business permits of the service centers from their co-dealership but those
 who belong to another co-dealership would probably not provide a copy of
 the business permits of their service centers because they are their
 competitor. He suggested that the certification from the authorized service
 center would be sufficient to replace the required business permit.
- ➤ Engr. Navarrete clarified that if a bidder can present a proof of engagement with the authorized service centers, then a copy of the requirements enumerated should be made available upon request.
- Engr. Navarrete emphasized that the purpose these proofs of after sales performance will give confidence to the government agencies of quality products.
- Mr. Salazar suggested that the Certification from the plant or the manufacturer of the list of Authorized Service Centers would be an assurance.
- ➤ Engr. Navarrete explained that the requirements are construed to be a value added service and is one of the best practices in government procurement.
- > Engr. Navarrete said that the proposed changes in the requirements will be subject to deliberation of the BAC.
- ➤ Engr. Navarrete highlighted the use of Performance Securing Declaration for purposes of compliance and submission of Performance Security.

	➤ It was emphasized that the Procuring Entity for the project is the Procurement Service. This signifies that during contract implementation, the winning bidder will have a contract with the Procurement Service. The winning bidder will deliver to the Project Sites and the Procurement Service will pay.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT	Engr. Navarrete emphasized that the delivery of the vehicles is nationwide. The government agencies will purchase the vehicles through Procurement Service. The winning bidder will deliver to the address of the requesting agencies.	
	➤ Engr. Navarrete discussed the concept of the Framework Agreement. He explained that Framework Agreement is an option contract. The government may buy some, all or none depending on the requests from government agencies. The delivery will depend on a Call-Off Order. Upon completion of the inspection and delivery and submission of documentary requirements, payment shall be made.	
	Engr. Navarrete emphasized that the project is for a Single Year Framework Agreement or for 12 months.

	> The provision was discussed for purposes of payment. It was emphasized that issuance of vehicle plate will no longer hold another 1% of the retention for the payment. Thus, the winning bidder will secure an undertaking to deliver the Plate Number upon availability.
	Mr. Aguirre clarified if unit prices may be adjusted if there are instances of inflation or currency fluctuation.
	> Engr. Navarrete remarked that inflation was already considered in the preparation of the recommended ABC.
	SECTION VI
	Mr. Estrada presented the form for the Schedule for Requirements and discussed the proper way of accomplishing the said form.
	Mr. Aguirre inquired on the concept of Call Off Order.
	Engr. Navarrete explained that a Call-Off Oder has the semblance of Delivery Order or Purchase Order and issued for every request or purchase of our client agencies. It includes the amount, item, quantity, schedule of delivery and the agency address where the item will be delivered.
	Mr. Aguirre inquired on the delivery place, inspection and acceptance.
SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS	> Engr. Navarrete said that the delivery place depends on the requesting agency nationwide.
i siya da Sanan wa masana na di sana sa da	> The vehicles will be inspected on the bidder's staging area that can be their manufacturing plant. The final acceptance will be at the delivery site.
	Mr. Aguirre inquired on the commencement of the delivery period.
	> Engr. Navarrete said that it is reckoned upon the issuance of the Call Off Order.
	 Mr. Aguirre asked, if the final acceptance can be done in the plant for payment purposes, then acknowledgment shall be made by the agencies upon delivery because the time for shipping schedule may not be controlled by their end.

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- > The suggestion will be subject for further deliberation and discussion with the BAC. Any amendment and/or clarification, if any, will be reflected in the BAC. As Bid Bulletin to be issued.
 - Mr. Aguirre suggested to determine quantity for each delivery site so that the delivery period can be clarified and agreed upon.
- Other prospective bidders manifested their agreement with the suggestion of Mr. Aguirre.
- Ms. Untalan on who will shoulder the shipping cost.
- > Engr. Navarrete said that the shipping cost be included in the bid price.
- Mr. Amper asked if there is a possibility that a several Call Off Orders will be issued within a month. He raised his concern regarding the quantities required to be delivered that might result to imposition of penalties.
- ➤ Engr. Navarrete explained that the Call Off Orders will be issued depending on the requests from the agencies; and yes, there is a possibility of several Call-Off Orders in a Framework Agreement.
- > Engr. Navarrete said that the indicative quantity per month will be reflected in the bid bulletin to be issued.
- Ms. Alegata requested to identify the delivery sites for purposes of determining the shipping cost.
- ➤ Engr. Navarrete said that the delivery will depend on the requesting agency. The delivery sites should be considered nationwide.
- Ms. Garcia asked if the payment for the unit and freight fee will be separate.
- > Engr. Navarrete said that the ABC is inclusive of freight/forwarding fee.
- Mr. Aguirre asked if the vehicles can be delivered if all the quantities are available.
- > Engr. Navarrete said deliveries will depend upon request of the agencies.

> Mr. Estrada presented the form for the Technical Specifications and discussed the proper way of accomplishing the said form.

Lot No. 7: Asian Utility Vehicle (AUV)/ Crossover Utility Vehicles (CUV):

Mr. Tubon said that the requirement is based on the DBM Budget Circular 2017-1. Mr. Tubon emphasized that the offered vehicle must be based on the manufacturer's standard. Any modifications to upgrade the unit offered to satisfy the requirement will not be allowed. Mr. Tubon reiterated that an agency specification complies with the following minimum requirements unless specified. Lot No. 8: Pick-Up Vehicle: "AGENCY SPECIFICATIONS - Brake, Front: Disc Rear: Disc XXX" Mr. Sanchez asked if the drum system for the rear break will be acceptable. Engr. Navarrete said that the inquiry will be subject for further deliberation and discussion with the BAC. Any amendment and/or clarification, if any, will be reflected in the Bid Bulletin to be issued.
