NOTICE OF DISAPPROVAL ON THE PS-DBM BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE VII (BAC VII) ISSUED RECOMMENDATION TO AWARD THE PROJECT ADVANCE WORK PACKAGE 1 (AWP1): DEMOLITION, TREE CUTTING AND UTILITY RELOCATION FOR CP102, CP103, CP104, CP105 AND CP108 UNDER PUBLIC BIDDING (PB) NO. 22-012-7

Reference is made to your letter dated 13 April 2023 requesting the DOTr Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) to issue a Notice of Disapproval/Cancellation based on the latter's Decision, disapproving the Procurement Service – Department of Budget and Management Bids and Awards Committee VII's (PS-DBM BAC VII) recommendation to Award the Project "Advance Work Package 1 (AWP1): Demolition, Tree Cutting and Utility Relocation for CP102, CP103, CP104, CP105 and CP108 under Public Bidding No. 22-012-7".

Pursuant to Section 37.1.3¹ of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the undersigned HoPE hereby issues this Notice of Disapproval on the PS-DBM BAC VII's recommendation to award the contract for the aforementioned Project, in view of the finality of the Decision² on the Protest filed by the sole eligible bidder, Joint Venture of MSV Construction & Supplies and 5 Jewel's Construction & Supply Corp., as embodied in the letter dated 03 November 2022 to the said bidder.
