The **Procurement Service-Department of Budget and Management (PS-DBM)** through its **Bids and Awards Committee II (BAC-II)** invites interested bidders to submit proposals, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) in the amount of Eight Hundred Forty Six Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (₱846,300.00) for the procurement of the items stated below:

Please quote your best proposal for the item described above using the Bid/Price Proposal Form (see Annex "A"), subject to terms and conditions stated in this Request for Proposal (RFP). **Annexes "A" and "B" must be submitted on/or before the deadline of submission of proposals.**

A Pre-proposal Conference will be held on **25 November 2024; 11:00 A.M** at PS Complex, Cristobal St., Paco, Manila and/or through video conferencing or webcasting via meet.google.com/mqj-ipv-tqeb, which shall be open to prospective bidders.

Proposals must be duly signed by you or your duly authorized representative, accompanied by the required forms, which shall be submitted not later than **28 November 2024; 2:00 P.M** at the address indicated below:

Opening of the proposals shall be held immediately after the deadline of submission.

Only one (1) set of original documents shall be required. The envelope shall contain the name of the contract to be bid in capital letters and bear the name and address of the supplier in capital letters. Other documents required **shall be submitted manually** to BAC-II at Procurement Service, 2nd Floor Lobby on or before the deadline of submission as stated in this RFP.

Unsealed or unmarked bid envelopes SHALL BE REJECTED. However, bid envelopes that are not properly sealed and marked, as required, shall be accepted, provided that the bidder or its duly authorized representative shall acknowledge such condition of the bid as submitted.

In case of modification, it must be done before the deadline for the submission and receipt of proposals, and labeled as a "modification". The time stamped or indicated in the latest proposal received shall be the official time of submission.

The BAC-II shall assume no responsibility for the misplacement of the contents of the improperly sealed or marked bid, or submission of corrupted files, or for its premature opening. **Late submission of proposal shall not be accepted and considered.**

In that case, the delivery must be made within the original delivery period or five (5) CDs from the release of the test result, whichever is later. For deliveries nationwide, a continuous random post-acceptance inspection may be conducted as applicable.*
5. *The supplier shall replace defective items, or refund payments made by PS-DBM for previously delivered items that were later found to be rampantly defective.*
6. *The bid shall be valid for sixty (60) calendar days from the deadline of submission of proposal.*
7. *Warranty Retention:*

Three (3) months after acceptance by the Procuring Entity of the delivered Goods or after the Goods are consumed, whichever is earlier.

In accordance with Section 62.1 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184, the obligations of the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to one percent (1%) of each payment, or special bank guarantee equivalent to one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amounts shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period.



- Type: 1 (National Flag)
- Size:
 - Length (-3mm): 1,828.8mm (6')
 - Width (-3mm): 914.4mm (3')
- Material: Cotton / Wool / Nylon / Wool and Nylon
- Color: Blue, Red, Golden Yellow and White (The colors must conform with the color requirements in the Heraldic Code of the Philippines as certified by the National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP))

EVIDENCE and VERIFICATION

- **Documentary Evidence to be submitted during Post-qualification:**
 - With Certificate of Accreditation from National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP) from the manufacturer.
- **In-House Test:**
 - Type: 1 (National Flag)
 - Determine the dimensions by using a measuring tape:
 - Length (-3mm): 1,828.8mm
 - Width (-3mm): 914.4mm
 - Stamp of Approval From National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP):
 - The TWG shall submit one (1) sample to the NHCP for evaluation during post qualification. . The sample must be stamped approved.
NOTE: The approved sample shall be the basis of evaluation during delivery.

PACKAGING

- Individually wrapped in plastic.
Ten (10) pieces per box.
- Each flag shall be folded properly and packed individually in a clear plastic with the manufacturer's label.

MARKING/LABELING

- Shall conform with the minimum Marking and Labeling Requirements under Article 77 of Republic Act 7394 (Consumer Act of the Philippines) whichever is/are applicable among those requirements to this item.

ANNEX A - Additional Requirements on Packaging

1. On each pack, box, item (whichever is applicable), the following shall be legibly imprinted:
 - The name and logo of the Procurement Service
 - A statement which states that the item is "For Government Use Only"
 - Procured by Procurement Service-DBM

The label must be printed on a non-removable or permanent sticker that is durable and when removed, will leave a residue.

2. If applicable:

On each corrugated carton, or outer box, or outer packaging, the following shall be legibly imprinted:

 - The name and logo of the Procurement Service
 - A statement which states that the item is "For Government Use Only"
 - Procured by Procurement Service-DBM

The label must be printed on a non-removable or permanent sticker that is durable and when removed, will leave a residue. The sticker must be placed on the dominant side of the box, and must be large enough to be seen and recognized from a short distance.
