SUBJECT: PUBLICATION/FLASHING OF NOTICES OF MAJOR

PROCUREMENT PROJECTS THROUGH PTV 4

DATE : 29 November 2017

Pursuant to Section 28, Article II of the 1987 Constitution which provides that the State shall adopt and implement a policy of full public disclosure of all its transactions involving public interest, PTV 4 is hereby DIRECTED to publish/flash the notices of major procurement projects of all government agencies, subdivisions, and instrumentalities, including government-owned or- controlled corporations, state universities and colleges, and local government units, in coordination with PhilGEPS.

PhilGEPS, as the single, centralized electronic portal that serves as the primary and definitive source of information on government procurement, is hereby DIRECTED to provide the necessary information that PTV 4 will need in order to perform the task stated above.

What is GOP-OMR?

"The **Government of the Philippines-Official Merchants** refers to the centralized electronic database of manufacturers, suppliers, distributors, contractors, and consultants developed and maintained by the PhilGEPS office pursuant to Section 8.2.2 of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184."



General Provisions

- 4.1. The GOP-OMR shall be the centralized electronic database of merchants for purposes of government electronic procurement.
 - Subject to Sections 7 to 9 herein, all existing registries of merchants, electronic or manual, used and maintained by procuring entities for government procurement shall be integrated with the GOP-OMR.
- 4.2. The PhilGEPS office shall not determine the eligibility of merchants. The PhilGEPS office's evaluation of the eligibility requirements shall be for the sole purpose of determining the approval or disapproval of the merchant's application for registration.
- 4.3. A merchant's registration and membership in the GOP-OMR is neither contract-specific nor understood to be tantamount to a finding of eligibility. Neither shall the merchant's successful registration in the GOP-OMR be relied upon to claim eligibility for the purpose of participation in any public bidding.
- 4.4. The determination of the eligibility of merchants, whether registered with the GOP-OMR or not, shall remain with the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC). The BAC's determination of validity of the eligibility requirements shall be conclusive to enable the merchant to participate in the public bidding process.

GPPB issued **Circular 07-2017** Deferring the Mandatory Submission of PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership

- Bidders may still submit their Class "A" Eligibility Documents required to be uploaded and maintained current and updated in the PhilGEPS pursuant to Section 8.5.2 of the same IRR, or if already registered in the PhilGEPS under Platinum category, their Certificate of Registration and Membership in lieu of their uploaded file of Class "A" Documents, or a combination thereof.
- In case the bidder opted to submit their Class "A" Documents, the Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration (Platinum Membership) shall remain as a post-qualification requirement to be submitted in accordance with Section 34.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184;

Manufacturers, suppliers, distributors, contractors and/or consultants are mandated to register with PhilGEPS and provide a PhilGEPS registration number in the following alternative methods of procurement <u>as a condition for award:</u>

- Direct Contracting
- Shopping 52.1b
- Take-over of contracts
- Highly Technical Consultants
- Small Value Procurement
- Lease of Real Property
- Scientific, Scholarly or Artistic Work, Exclusive Technology and
- NGO Participation

Except for the following;

- Shopping under unforeseen Contingency
- Emergency Cases
- Agency to Agency
- Defense Cooperation Agreements
- Community Participation
- United Nations Agency, International Organizations International Financing Institutions

Upon approval of the documents, payment details will be sent via the registered email. Suppliers must use the indicated information upon payment via LandBank of the Philippines or Cashier at PhilGEPS Ortigas Office.



PROVIDE A COPY OF O.R. OR ONCOLL PAYMENT SLIP

Upon payment, Supplier shall provide the Official Receipt or validated oncoll payment slip to the PhilGEPS by replying to the email received regarding payment or via walk-in.

Upon validation of the payment, PhilGEPS will provide a copy of the Certificate of Platinum Membership to the Supplier via email (if online application) or printed copy (if walk-in).

Pursuant to Section 8.5.2 of the Revised IRR of RA 9184, all bidders shall upload and maintain in PhilGEPS a current and updated file of the following Class "A" eligibility documents under Sections 23.1(a) and 24.1(a) of the same IRR:

- Business Registration Certificate
- Mayor's or Business Permit or its equivalent document
- Tax Clearance
- Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB) license and registration, and
- Audited Financial Statements (AFS)

These documents shall be accompanied by a **Sworn Statement** (click here to download template) stating that the submitted documents are complete and authentic copies of the original, and all statements and information provided are true and correct.

Please take note of the following reminders before proceeding to the next page:

- Scan all your documents completely and properly. Make sure that details are clear and readable.

This facility is for **new, update and renewal** of platinum membership certificate. Only **registered suppliers** can use this facility and only applications submitted via this facility will be processed..


